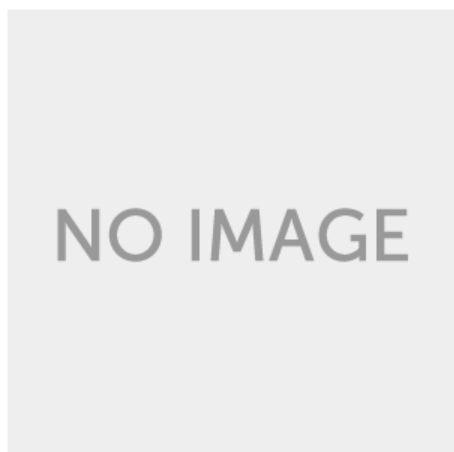
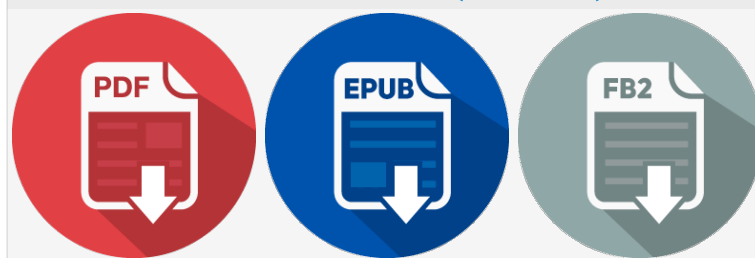


## The Pedestrian and City Traffic *by* Carmen Hass-Klau
